

# Cannons of Conduct

In an attempt to provide for everyone's safe enjoyment of Bainbridge BikeFest, you must adhere to the following. Failure to do so will result in removal from the event without reimbursement of fees paid. Criminal charges may be made, where applicable, at the discretion of the Decatur County Sheriff's Office.

**1) No ATV's or any other Vehicle which is not legal to drive on the streets. Limited use of golf carts and side by side low performance Utility Vehicles is allowed see #13.**

- 2) You may not vend, sell, distribute, or solicit for any cause, for pay or for free, without the written permission of Bainbridge BikeFest, Inc.
- 3) Armbands must be worn at all times either on wrist or on vest.
- 4) Coolers Allowed in camping areas **ONLY**.
- 5) **No one under 18 is allowed to attend Bainbridge BikeFest.**
- 6) No glass bottles on BikeFest Property.
- 7) No Open Fires.
- 8) No vehicle parking on any roadway unless specifically designated for parking.
- 9) All signs must be obeyed.
- 10) No blocking of roadways.
- 11) Motorcycles, Handicap Carts, and Official BikeFest vehicles are the only vehicles allowed in the designated area in front of the stage.

**12) NO UNDERAGE DRINKING ALLOWED, MUST BE 21 OR OVER.**

- 13) Golf Carts and Utility Vehicles pose a traffic hazard for motorcycles. Such vehicles require a \$30 fee per vehicle and must have headlights as well as taillights. Golf carts & Utility Vehicles will be allowed access to venue and vendors, but there will be a motorcycle only area. **THIS IS A MOTORCYCLE RALLY. PLEASE BRING YOUR MOTORCYCLE.**  
Only low performance vehicles will be allowed. BikeFest Gate Supervisor's or Camper Parking Supervisor's decision on allowing a particular vehicle will be final.
- 14) No Fighting. Decatur County Sheriff's Office **WILL** be bringing charges against any one engaging in a fight and they will be removed from BikeFest.
- 15) All Local, State, and Federal laws apply.
- 16) No Public Nudity.
- 17) Vehicles other than motorcycles and golf carts/utility vehicles may be in campground only to access your camp or leave the grounds. No cruising in trucks, autos, etc will be allowed. Only two will be allowed in campground per campsite.
